Severance Pay and Resignation: Namibian High Court Puts the Debate to Rest 8 April 2025

Severance pay is, by definition, only payable upon resignation or retirement at the age of 65, provided the employee has completed 12 months of continuous employment. Reaching this age is a peremptory jurisdictional requirement that must be present for a successful severance pay claim.
